Inclusive Health is a state program offering a new health insurance option for individuals with pre-existing medical conditions having difficulty finding affordable coverage. It is primarily geared to residents with pre-existing conditions, those who have exhausted their COBRA continuation benefits and trade displaced workers. With premiums capped by state law, Inclusive Health is often less expensive than traditional individual insurance coverage for people with pre-existing conditions.

HURRY: Applications approved before June 30 will have the pre-existing condition waiting period cut in half (from 12 to six months). There is no waiting period for individuals with COBRA or trade displaced workers.

During the June 3rd enrollment event, experts will be available to help with eligibility questions and assisting individual through the enrollment process. They can also answer questions or compare benefit plans and premium rates.
